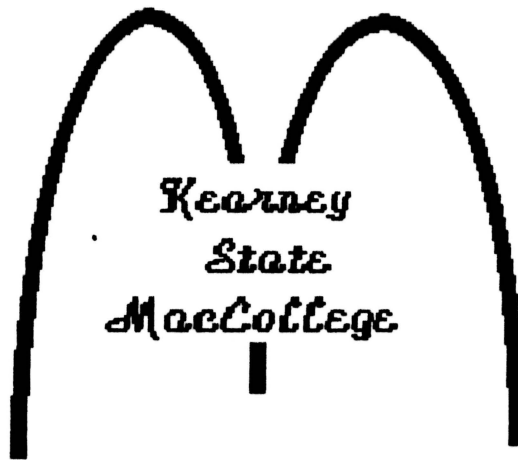

RE: Nuclear War

A number of faculty members has asked me to clarify official school policy concerning nuclear attack. The policy is basically the same as the snow day policy with the following revisions:

- (a) After the first thermonuclear detonation, the last day to withdraw will be moved back two weeks.
- (b) Library hours will be reduced to usual weekend hours.
- (c) Classes will meet Monday through Thursday only.
- (d) Temperature in campus buildings will be reduced to 1200° F.
- (e) Faculty offices will be provided in the steam tunnels.
- (f) Outdoor Physical Education classes will not meet until radiation levels reach a safe level.
- (g) Biology faculty members will assume responsibility for checking radiation levels.
- (h) Current parking permits will remain in effect.
- (i) The Military Science faculty will assume responsibility for parking citations.
- (j) The hook switch flash phone policy will be eliminated.
- (k) The Nebraska Civil Defense will assume responsibility for academic program review.
- (l) Commencements will be held only on Fridays.
- (m) The name of KSC will automatically become University of Nebraska -Kearney.

The above policies do not apply to the School of Fine Arts and Humanities. FAH faculty should consult with Dr. Becker-Theye.
