  - Benson/Schneider-Cline moved to approve the pilot of the restructuring of LOPR 126.
  - Brown stated the goal is to have one section from each college to teach a pilot course of the new LOPR 126.
  - Hartman stated she spoke with several faculty and they have big concerns with the restructuring of LOPR 126 (not feasible to remain interdisciplinary, need to have a better sense of what is LOPER 1).

    will still be LNSK courses offered. Gibbs stated one of the LNSK
    courses would likely go away.
  - Brown stated that the change in LOPER 1 is in response to the General Studies Academic Program Review as well as the administrative challenges to the current structure of LOPR 126.
  - Boeckner asked how the Council would assess whether the pilot is working. Gibbs stated using the Thompson Scholars assessment structure could be incorporated as a formal assessment.
