Call for Papers

MPJBT is a no-fee, open access, double blind peer-reviewed journal published by the **College of Business and Technology at the University of Nebraska at Kearney**. The journal publishes original scholarly research, conceptual and empirical papers, industry notes, invited essays, case studies, and book reviews² that are of interest to academics or practitioners. From time to time, the journal will publish special issues devoted to important topics in business and associated technologies.

For this issue the focus of the journal will be on CYBER SYSTEMS, and we invite manuscripts that will be of great interest to both *practitioners and academics*. Articles with both pedagogical and managerial significance that address current trends and challenges in the area are sought. Cyber-related topics such as Cyber Operations, Cyber Security, Cyber Fraud, Cyber Threats, Digital Forensics, Ransomware, Cyber Conflict, etc. as they impact on SMEs, non-profits, institutions of higher learning, government agencies and other organizations are encouraged.
